Two claims made by Jesus

Everyone who hears these words and puts them into practice withstands the storms.

Everyone who hears these words and DOES NOT put them into practice is crushed by the storms.

The storms endured by people

Jesus is talking about how His followers are to live as citizens of the Kingdom of God even while they receive pressure and temptation from a culture that does not know God.

Two very different outcomes by those who endure those storms

Build on the rock – your house stands.

Build on the sand – your house falls.
