2) Hate what is evil and cling to what is good.

As we move from postmodern to post-truth, this is going to be a point of contention with the culture.

Woe to those who call evil good and good evil (Isaiah 5:20)

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3) Be devoted to one another in brotherly love.

The beauty of ______ CAN BE one of the first things that people notice when they walk into a gathering of God's people.

Saved people who are being transformed by Jesus live differently. This is one of the ways the gospel takes on flesh – the people of God put the gospel of God on display.

4) Be patient in affliction.
